

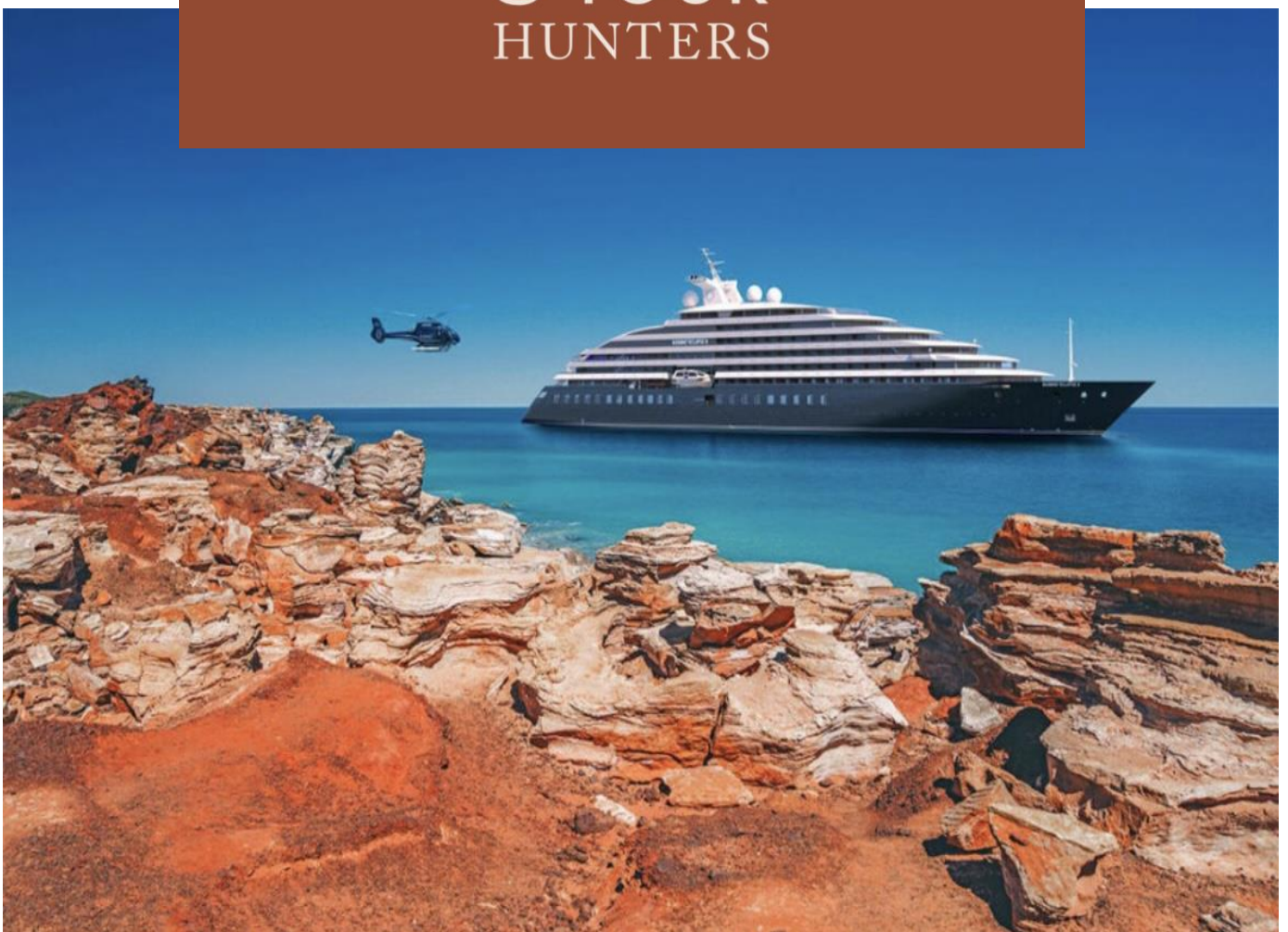

Day 1 – Thursday 27th June - Signature Gardens ~ Broome

Depart Sydney Airport on a direct Qantas flight to Broome at 8:25am. Arrive into Broome at 11:40am and make your own way to the Oaks Broome Hotel, your accommodation where you will spend the next two nights.

Day 2 – Friday 28th June – Broome Panoramic Day Tour (B, Light nibbles & bubbles)

Today at 12:00 midday be picked up from your accommodation and enjoy a full commentary tour. We begin in Chinatown hearing fascinating stories of this colourful precinct. Enjoy a historical sound show at the famous Sun Pictures, the world's oldest operating open air picture garden, learn about the ancient art of pearling from one of the local pearl producers & take a drive through Old Broome architecture and old Pearling Masters homes before viewing the aqua waters of Roebuck Bay at Town Beach and learning of Broome's One Day War. Visit the Japanese Cemetery and travel by the Broome Racecourse, before taking an easy paced walk at Gantheaume Point and hear the story of Anastasia's Pool. Then stop at Matsos Broome Brewery to sample their hand made ales and famous ginger beer (included) Then drive down onto Cable Beach for sunset (subject to beach conditions). Relax and enjoy a stroll, swim, or light refreshments (included) as you watch the sun disappear into the horizon. A drop off to your accommodation is provided or you may like to enjoy a cocktail or dinner at one of the nearby cafes at approximately 6.00 pm.

Day 3 - 13 – Saturday 29th June – Tuesday 09th July – On board Scenic Eclipse (BLD)

Today you embark on a journey of a lifetime, travel with absolute ease upon the Scenic Eclipse discovery yacht! 6-star ultra-luxury with only 228 passengers, this cruise has been designed for a more intimate experience with dining, beverages, discovery excursions and entertainment all included.

Day 13 - Tuesday 09th July (BD)

Covering nearly 20,000 square kilometres, Kakadu National Park has a World Heritage listing renowned for both its cultural and natural values.

Day 15 – Thursday 11th July – Darwin City Tour

Darwin is a multicultural city with a population made up of people from more than 60 different nationalities and 70 different ethnic backgrounds. Spend the day with a local guide exploring the city sites such as the botanic gardens, the museum and art gallery and learn more about the air raid that took place in WWII.

This evening you may consider a visit to Mindil Beach Markets. An iconic weekly event in the Top End! There will be many choices to have dinner!

Day 16 – Friday 12th July – Litchfield Day Tour (L)

Today we explore Litchfield National Park including a crocodile spotting cruise along the Adelaide River. Today make sure to bring a towel and swimwear as there will be an incredible opportunity to swim in one of the most picturesque places on earth!

Day 17 – Saturday 13th July – Home

Your journey comes to a close today, with an easy morning to pack, wander around Darwin or sit back and relax. Make your own way to the airport for a direct Qantas flight departing Darwin at 1:10pm. Arrive in Sydney at 5:50pm and make your own way home.

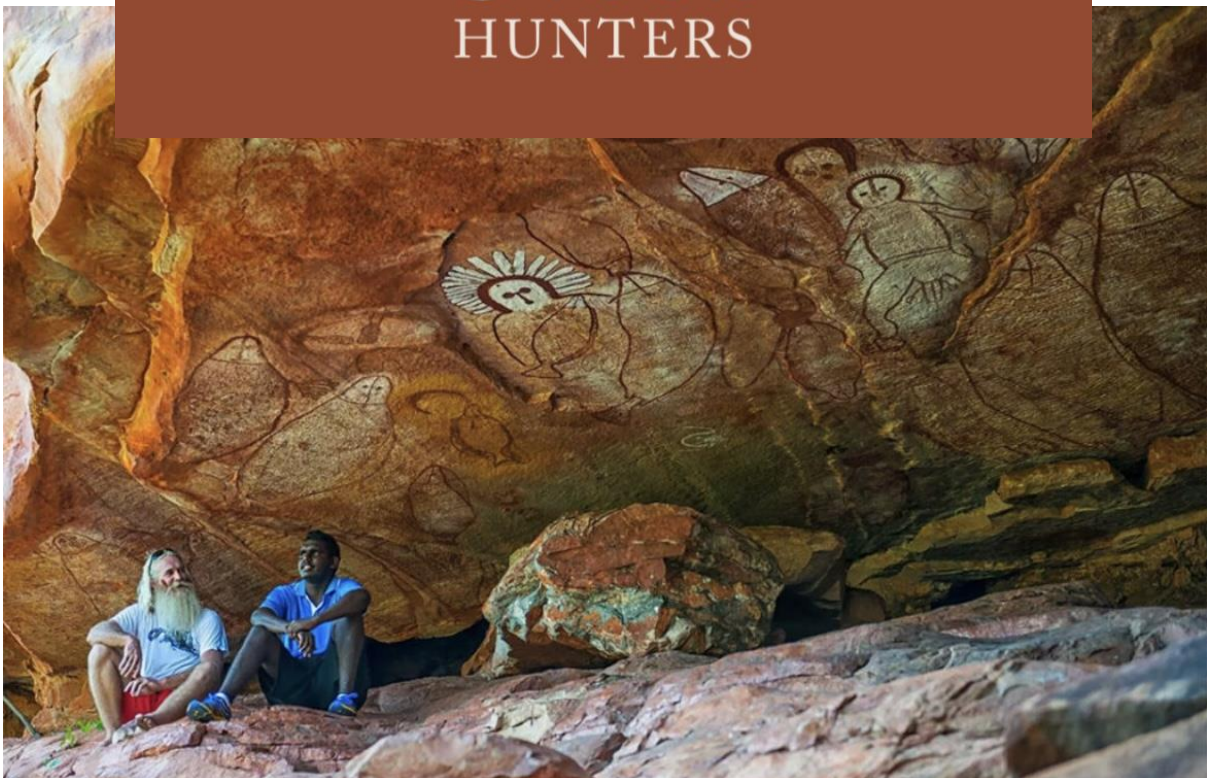
